
News from the Schools



Original **Crabapple School Bell**, c. 1878, hung at1968 HemisFair World's Fair and continued at Institute of Texan Cultures for several years before returning the bell to **Crabapple School**. WILLOW CITY School completed and installed one of two new bookcases to safely store over 500 hundred schoolbooks. Cases have glass doors which lock.

CAVE CREEK School reported the addition of a new refrigerator/freezer.





WILLIAMS CREEK SCHOOL members accomplished a major goal in 2019, with the installation of eight new energy efficient windows in the original stone school replacing the 1950's aluminum windows. Maintenance done was the replacement of restroom fixtures, repair of the water heater, and the installation of a water softener. There was touch up painting on the outside of the restrooms, the repainting of the railing between the restroom and school, and touch up work on the wooden windows in the tin part of the school, and the repair and painting of the cupola.
